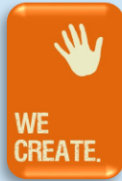

Expansion of Free School Meals

The Scottish Government has paused the roll out of free school meals for Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils.

The Government's decision was made to allow further work with COSLA, the national association of Scottish Councils, and all local authorities to fully assess the financial and infrastructure challenges that have been highlighted for the final phase of the expansion plans. I will be in touch with further information when a decision is taken by the government to progress the roll-out to all Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils.

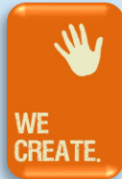
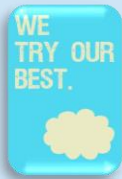

ParentsPortal.scot

We are due to complete the annual data check form. Aberdeenshire Council guidelines state that this must be completed through parentsportal.scot. No Annual Data Check information will be given to pupils to take home in their school bag.

Parentsportal.scot is available in all Aberdeenshire Councils Primary and Secondary schools, and since its launch uptake has varied across schools. Currently 76% of children and young people are linked to parentsportal.scot

Who can use parentsportal.scot

Access to parentsportal.scot is only for those parents or carers who have children in Primary 1 to the final year of secondary and are already confirmed as a contact for that child. This is normally the person who already receives electronic information from a child(ren)'s school and completes the annual data check form.

How to sign up for parentsportal.scot

Parentsportal.scot is accessed via [myAberdeenshire](https://myaberdeenshire.gov.uk).

If you don't already use [myAberdeenshire](https://myaberdeenshire.gov.uk), you will need to create an account and you can do that by [registering for myaccount](#). Select 'Register', then 'Create a new account'.

Whether you are a new or existing [myAberdeenshire](https://myaberdeenshire.gov.uk) user there are two things you will need to do to be able to access parentsportal.scot:

- consent to sharing your data with parentsportal.scot
- [link your child's details to your account](#)

What you will see in parentsportal.scot

To start with, you will see basic information about your child(ren)'s school along with online services such as a link to paying for school meals and completing your child(ren)'s annual data check form electronically.

As we introduce new online services, you may find that some new online services either do not hold any information or do not appear to do anything. This is because we will be testing the online services before we activate it. We will keep you informed when new online services become available.
