WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF FRIENDS OR STAFF ARE UNWELL IN MY SCHOOL?

Anyone who is unwell will go home straight away. The School, Aberdeenshire Council and NHS Grampian will monitor the number of COVID-19 cases carefully.

The NHS will let people know if they need to self-isolate but it is really important to not attend school if you are showing symptoms of COVID-19 or if someone you live with is showing symptoms.

People who have symptoms need to be tested.



WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF SOMEONE IN MY SCHOOL TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19?

Mr Anderson will contact Public Health in NHS Grampian. We might need to self-isolate or close our school to keep everyone safe.

NHS Grampian will help us by telling us if we need to do this.
