

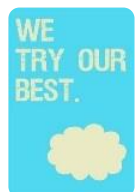
What is Pupil Equity Funding (P.E.F.)?

It is money that our school receives to help provide you with the best possible opportunities to achieve.

It helps us to support children who experience barriers to learning.

It helps provide equity.

Our school received £4699 to do this.



What are we doing now?

We are going to help you develop skills for learning, life and work. To do this we will:

- Talk about the skills you are developing.
- Provide everyone with equal chances to develop skills for learning, life and work.
- Record and celebrate the skills you are developing and identify any gaps in our skills development.

What has P.E.F achieved in our school in the past?

- We have carried out a survey of your wellbeing using the Wellbeing Indicators and engagement using the Leuven Scale. We developed a DEN in our school (Developing our Emotion and Nurture Space) to improve our wellbeing.
- We used *The Cost of The School Day Toolkit* with your Parents/Carers to look at the aspects of our school life that puts pressure on families. We have changed the way we do some things. We have free school uniform available, contribute money towards school trips etc.
- We held a Family Learning Event to share how we learn to read in our school. We purchased new resources to help improve the way we learn.
