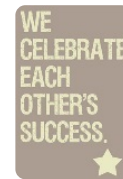
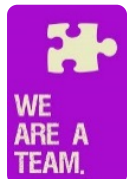
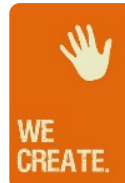
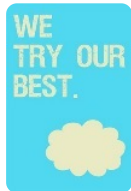


# Barthol Chapel School – Pupil Equity Fund Update (P.E.F.)

## What is Pupil Equity Funding (P.E.F.)?

Pupil Equity Funding is money that will go to your child's school to help them provide the best possible opportunities for children's learning. In particular, it is there to help the school support children who experience barriers to learning and who might be falling behind or not getting the same chances in their education because their family is experiencing poverty or other financial difficulties. This money is given to schools as part of the Scottish Government's Scottish Attainment Challenge.



## What are our next steps?

- Continue to improve our attainment in literacy and numeracy.
- Develop the range of opportunities our learners have to participate in a range of clubs and events, in particular those who do not have this opportunity.
- To understand the cost of the school day at Barthol Chapel School to implement a range of impactful policy and practice changes to support children and families.

## What have we achieved this school year?

- Enhanced our approaches to Numeracy by learning through innovative learning experiences which enable our learners to be creative, problem solve and lead their own learning. Attainment increased by 3%.
- Raised the profile of reading in our school through new initiatives and resources to support learning & teaching. Attainment increased by 6%.
- Held a Family Learning Event to share how we deliver high quality reading experiences for our learners.
- Focused on improving the consistency of learning and teaching in our school by developing a revised Learning & Teaching Policy.
